KEY FACTS

- More than \$56.7 million has been approved for 23,728 households.
- 35,152 home inspections have been completed.
- Disaster Survivor Assistance crews have visited more than 27,600 homes.
- · Michigan homeowners and renters in Eaton, Ingham, Ionia, Kent, Livingston, Macomb, Monroe, Oakland and Wayne counties can apply for FEMA assistance.
- The deadline to apply for assistance is Monday, April 8, 2024.

KEY MESSAGES

- There's only one month left to apply for assistance. You can apply even if you've already made repairs or started your recovery.
- You don't have to be a U.S. citizen to apply for assistance. If a member of your household is a citizen, non-citizen national or a qualified alien, you can join their application for assistance.
- Disaster Unemployment Assistance is available for those who lost work as a direct result of the August storms. Apply by March 27, 2024. Download an application here.
